What information does CruCon.com collect?

We are committed to providing you with high-quality services and exciting travel offers. With these goals in mind, we are providing you with this information to help you understand our site and to assist you when making decisions about the use of our site. While we may continuously evaluate our business practices, we may collect two types of information from your use of our web site (1) personally identifiable information that you choose to provide or (2) web site use information that is collected as you and others browse on our web site. Information Collection and Use

Cookies

A cookie is a piece of data stored on a user's hard drive containing information about the user. They may simplify subsequent transactions with that website or use the information to streamline the user's transactions on related web pages. Once the user closes their browser, the cookie simply terminates. For instance, by setting a cookie on our site, the user would not have to log in a password more than once, thereby saving time while on our site. Log Files

We may use IP addresses to analyze trends, administer the site, track user's movement, and gather broad demographic information (e.g., age, income, online shopping preferences) for aggregate use. IP addresses are not linked to personally identifiable information.

We may disclose your information to promotion partners or other third parties if we have obtained your consent to do so. We also may disclose your information to courts, law enforcement authorities, and relevant third parties such as internet service providers, when such is disclosure is necessary or advisable, in our sole discretion, to conduct an investigation, comply with court order or subpoena, prevent harm to others, or protect our legal rights or those of other users or third parties. We may share aggregated demographic information with our partners, affiliates and advertisers, but this will not include any personally identifying data except as otherwise provided in this policy.
